Katherine Marie (Carnes) Netto of Springdale died December 21, 2018 at Katherine's Place on Weddington in Fayetteville. She was born August 9, 1922 in Springdale, Arkansas to E.B. (Sam) and Katherine Morton.

Katherine attended Shady Grove and Appleby Elementary Schools and graduated from Springdale High School. She attended Fayetteville Business College and was employed by Budd Post and Hardwood Company. She married and her husband, who had just gotten out of the military, moved to Kansas City where he was to attend college. She was employed by Columbia Ribbon and Carbon Company at the time. They moved back to Fayetteville after his schooling and she worked for Hunt's Department Store as Credit Manager for 21 years until Hunt's sold their store.
