Betty Ann (Moore) Killman, age 80, of Bentonville, Arkansas passed away Saturday, June 4, 2022 at Circle of Life Hospice in Springdale. She was born December 12, 1941 in Wheaton, Missouri, the daughter of Nelson Robert and Mildred Eva (Allen) Moore. On May 31, 1959, at her parents home in Verona, Missouri, she was united in marriage to the Love of Her Life, Hosea Paul Killman.
