Beverly Anne Sanders Phillips Charleton, 76 of Springdale passed away Tuesday, September 26, 2022 at Circle of Life Hospice in Bentonville. She was born March 5, 1946 in Fort Smith, Arkansas to Raymond Robert Sanders and Bobby Dora Homeyer Sanders and later moved to Springdale and attended Springdale Schools until graduation in 1964 and then attended Arkansas Tech.

She married Phil Phillips in 1966 and enjoyed her life as a coach's wife in each place she lived. They welcomed their only child together, Brooke on June 17, 1969. They moved back to Springdale in 1973 where she would spend the rest of her life.
