Billy Joe George, 78 of Springdale died Saturday, September 12, 2009 at Northwest Medical Center in Springdale. He was born July 31, 1931 in Arkansas City, Kansas to W.E. and Mamie Maxey George.

Billy Joe served in the United States Army Guard retiring as Sgt. 1st Class. He also served in Korea from 1949 to 1951. He was one of the original three founding members of the Springdale National Guard Armory. He was a member of the VFW, Springdale Post 2952. He was a truck driver for Jones Truck Lines for fifteen years and he also worked for International Paper Company. He was a member of the First Church of the Nazarene in Fayetteville where he sang in the choir and in the Church Quartet. He was Scout Master for Boy Scout Troop 112 in Springdale from 1965 to 1969. He was preceded in death by one brother Herbert L. George and one sister Helen Pinkley.

Survivors include his wife Peggy Jo (High) George of the home to whom he was married on August 15, 1951; two sons Randy Lewis George and wife Vicki and Robert Harlan George and wife Lenda all of Springdale; two grandchildren, Jonathan Weston George of Springdale and Trisha Ann Williams of Springfield, Missouri.
