Billy Frank Grigg, 82 of Springdale, AR was greeted at Heaven's gate by his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, on February 13, 2026 surrounded by his loving family.

He was born on January 2, 1944 in Little Field, TX to Houston & Thelma Grigg. Bill graduated from Springdale High School in 1962. In 1966, he was drafted by the Army and served his country in the Vietnam war. His honors included the National Defense Service Medal, Good Conduct Medal, Vietnam Service Medal, and Vietnam Campaign Medal, with an Honorable Discharge in 1972.

Bill was a devoted husband to his loving wife of 59 years, Mattie Grigg. A father of 57 years who cherished his daughter Melissa. He was the perfect proud "Pa" to Deven & Danielle for 33 years. He was honorary "Daddy Bill" to many of Melissa's best friends. Just as much, was his love for his nieces and nephews, extended family and close friends.

Bill's love of Bluegrass music was known by all of those close to him. He and Mattie would often travel to other states to enjoy the pure, wholesome sound of their favorite gospel bluegrass groups. Survivors include his wife, Mattie Grigg, daughter Melissa Reagan and husband Dean. Grandson Deven Goddard and wife Jordyn and granddaughter Danielle Reagan.
