Gene Bruce McElroy, Jr., 49, of Springdale died Tuesday, February 8, 2011 at Circle of Life Hospice in Springdale after a long battle with cancer. He was born April 30, 1961 in Ft. Worth, Texas to Gene Bruce McElroy, Sr. and Dorothy Ann Chaney McElroy.

He was an active member of the First United Methodist Church in Springdale and the church's Men's Fraternity. Over the years he held various positions such as committee member of the Children's World board, the "Expanding Our Blessings" Management Team, and Chairman of the Building and Grounds Committee.
