Carl Richard Stamper, 77, of Tontitown, passed away Saturday, June 1, 2024, at Baptist Health in Little Rock, Arkansas. He was born March 7, 1947, in Macon, Missouri, to Billy Stamper and Lucille Jeter Stamper.

He spent his early years in Madison, Missouri, where his father worked at the local newspaper. At age five, Carl's family moved to Elsberry, Missouri, where he enjoyed a wonderful childhood filled with his passion for baseball. His love for sports continued throughout his youth, playing basketball and football and excelling in baseball during his high school years in New Hampton, Iowa. Carl's athletic talents were evident from a young age, earning him recognition and letters in multiple sports.

After graduating high school in 1965, Carl's family moved to Arkansas, where he attended Ellsworth Junior College and later transferred to Arkansas Tech. In 1969, Carl met the love of his life, Connie Blalock. They married on October 4, 1969, and enjoyed 35 beautiful years together.

Connie passed away in 2004 after a battle with leukemia. Despite the challenges, Carl remained a devoted father and grandfather, finding joy in his family and the memories they created together. He had a deep love for watching horse racing, a hobby he continued to enjoy later in life.

Richard was preceded in death by his parents, his wife, Connie J Stamper, and one great-grandson, Wyatt Matthew Baugh.
