Charles Amedee Balsley, Jr., 63 of Springdale died Thursday, September 13, 2012 at Regency Hospital in Fayetteville. He was born August 17, 1949 in Uniontown, Pennsylvania to Charles Amedee Balsley Sr. and Elizabeth Weltner Balsley.

Charles served in the United States Air Force for 30 years. He served in the Vietnam Conflict and the Gulf War.
