Charles Lorraine Davenport, 99, of Springdale, passed away Sunday, February 1, 2026, at Circle of Life Hospice in Springdale. He was born August 17, 1926, in Iola, Kansas, to Frank Davenport and Wanda Lillian Cleaver Davenport.
