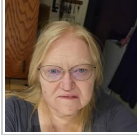

Ed had been working frantically on his Jeep and had driven it up to talk to dad. Ed and Jr (my dad) had thier heads under the hood of something in the back yard. Rosie went in the house to talk to Betty Rhea (my mom) who was working in the kitchen. I was reclining on a lounge chair soaking up some rays in the side yard close to Ed's Jeep. I had been lighting off fireworks earlier and had some smoke bombs left. I walked over and very quietly lit 2 or 3 smoke bombs and placed them under the hood in front of the radiator. Closed the hood and latched it..... returned to my chair and waited for the smoke to look bad (didn't take long!). Then I started screaming at Ed that there was something wrong with his Jeep. He and dad came running ALL EXCITED! Of course mom and Rosie were yelling from the dinning room windows. As they got the hood lifted and realized what was going on..... they looked at me. Dad said shaking his finger that wasn't very nice..... but everyone had to laugh because it was cute! I didn't really get into any trouble..... but that is my most favorite memory of Ed. I loved that man like my father. He will be missed. I'm so sorry for your loss.
