We are heartbroken to announce the passing of Dr. Dale G. Huntington Sr., 75, on December 9, 2023. He was born August 3, 1948 and grew up in a loving household in Paola, KS. After graduating from Paola High School, he attended Cleveland Chiropractic College in Kansas City, MO and followed his father's footsteps into chiropractic medicine. Dale and Teresa met on a blind date set up by her grandmother who happened to live next door to his parents in Paola. After graduating with his doctorate in chiropractic medicine he took a chance on moving to NWA to start his own practice. Soon after, he and Teresa were married.

He had a successful practice in Springdale for 49 years. He was loved by his patients who referred to him as "Doc." He was passionate about the chiropractic profession and served on/lead councils at the state and national level. He traveled to Washington DC to lobby for the profession he loved. He was an active member in Kiwanis and at St. Thomas Episcopal Church. When he wasn't giving back to the community through volunteering his time, you could find him tinkering with or driving his Corvette. He was a great husband, a loving father, a doting grandfather, and the absolute BEST chiropractor in NWA. He was beloved by all for his kind nature, service-oriented heart, and his wicked sense of humor.
