After retiring from the floral business, Dorothy focused on her own flowers in her flower garden. She enjoyed gardening and her garden clubs. She was a past member of Terra Firma Garden Club, and was a current member of The Garden Club of Rogers. She was also a member of Floralia Arranger's Guild and a longtime member of the Northwest Arkansas District of Arkansas

Garden Clubs. Dorothy was also past president of the Springdale Memorial Hospital Auxiliary and also a volunteer for the NARTI auxiliary.
