



## Douglas Ross Sharp

July 20, 1953 - March 9, 2025

It is with deep sorrow that we announce the passing of Douglas Ross Sharp, 71, of Tontitown, who passed away on March 9, 2025. He was a proud veteran of the U.S. Air Force, having honorably served from 1971 to 1975.

Born on July 20, 1953, in Huntsville, Doug dedicated his life to serving others through a diverse career in healthcare administration. He had a passion for working with physicians and nurses and reaching communities with medical services throughout Northwest Arkansas. He prized continuous education and returned to school mid-career to earn a Bachelor of Science in Organizational Management from John Brown University in 1997.
