Erma Louise Plumlee went to be with the Lord on June 3, 2013 in Springdale, just six days short of her 95th birthday. She was born on June 9, 1918 to Myron (Pete) & Zulema Teters in Holdenville, OK.

She was a 1936 graduate of Springdale High School where she played basketball for the Lady Bulldogs. While in high school she worked at Harp's Grocery Store on East Emma Ave in Springdale.

She married Marvin Plumlee on October 1, 1938. She worked at the Arkansas Brokerage on Emma Ave for many years before rejoining Harp's IGA as a checker until her retirement in 1977. Even after retirement, she continued to serve Harp's in a limited capacity as a secret shopper. She also filled her early retirement years as a substitute teacher in the Springdale School District.

Louise also taught 4 year olds in Sunday School for several decades and was a member of (First Baptist Church) Cross Church of Springdale.

She was preceded in death by her parents, husband, Marvin, one son, Harold Dean Plumlee, one brother, three sisters, and one granddaughter, Tammie Louise Plumlee.
