Ernestine Violet Tedford Power, 87 of Springdale, AR passed away on February 16, 2018 at Circle of Life Hospice in Springdale. She was born in the community of Bethlehem in Lonoke County, AR on July 11, 1930 to Luther and Golden Tedford.
