Eva Lee "McDonald" Armstrong, 88, resident of Springdale, passed away April 27, 2008 at The Maples in Springdale. She was the firstborn of eight children of Huey Rodney and Hattie Viola Stuart Thompson. She was preceded in death by two sisters, Leta Wilson and Dorothy Davis, one brother, Bob Thompson and one infant son Oliver, Jr.
