Evelyn "Carol" Sutherland, 79, of Lowell, AR, passed away in her home with family by her side on November 20, 2019, after a hard-fought battle with cancer. In hospice care for four weeks prior to her death, Carol died peacefully in her sleep.

She graduated from Bolivar High School in 1958. Carol was a loving wife and homemaker for the biggest part of her life, working tirelessly to make most of her children's clothes as well as her own. She became a Christian in early adulthood and was a lifelong church member, raising her children to be strong followers of Christ as well. Most recently, Carol was a member of Elmdale Baptist Church in Springdale, AR.

In her later years, she was a caretaker for her mother for a period of time. She also was available to care for her grandchildren for extended periods, much to

everyone's delight. She loved to play games and never "let" anyone win, so her children and grandchildren have a strong, competitive spirit.
