February 13, 1927 - June 6, 2010

Lifetime Springdale resident, Everett Harrison "Jack" Fitzgerald, age 83, was called from his earthly home to his heavenly home on Sunday, June 6, 2010 after a brief battle with cancer.

He was born to Oddless Harrison and Ina Jane (Ballenger) Fitzgerald on February 13, 1927. He attended Oak Grove School, and later served in the United States Army where he was stationed in Japan. After returning from duty, he married his childhood sweetheart, Christine Hairston on May 15, 1949.

He was an over-the-road truck driver for Jones Truck Lines for over 30 years. He was known by all who met him to be a man of great Christian character who loved his Lord, family, country and friends. He was a master storyteller, and his funny stories and anecdotes kept everyone laughing.

He was preceded in death by his parents, his sister and brother in law Ethel and Johnny Gobble and his son, Doug.
