



Floyd Lee Allred

July 31, 1939 - December 19, 2024

Floyd Lee Allred, 85, passed away Thursday, December 19, 2024. The son of Dess and Lizzie Lee Allred, he was born on July 31, 1939 in the Greeley, Colorado area. Floyd was a kind, sensitive and strong man who loved hunting, fishing and observing wildlife. His greatest love, next to his wife Cora and his dog Kylee, was the great outdoors.

Floyd enlisted in the United States Army on August 22, 1958 and retired as a Master Sergeant (E-8) with 21 years of service on September 1, 1979. His service included the Vietnam War, where he earned the Bronze Star for valour in combat as well as numerous other commendations and service medals. He won top marksmanship awards in German competitions. After retirement from the military, Floyd served an additional 16 years at the VA Hospital in Fayetteville, AR as a nurse assistant.

Floyd is preceded in death by his mother, father, three sisters, one brother, and a son, Christopher. He is survived by his wife Cora Lee, son Curtis of Fayetteville, his daughter Cindy Stanley of Martinsville, Virginia, four step children, Steve Nimmo of North Bonneville, Washington, Mike Nimmo of Goshen, Arkansas, Debbie Hocott of Ft Smith, Arkansas, and Mark Nimmo of Pittsboro, North Carolina, a brother, Joy Ray (Buddy), a sister, Fern Lovella Rush, and numerous grandchildren.

Floyd's remains will be interred with full military honors at the Fayetteville National Cemetery during a graveside service on Monday, December 30, 2024 at 12:30 pm.
