Francis Earl Hull, Jr., 86 of Springdale passed away Friday, September 27, 2024 at his home. He was born March 22, 1938 in Walsh, Colorado to Francis Earl Hull, Sr. and Elma Lasley Hull.

Francis was a member of Fellowship Bible Church in Rogers. He taught Bible study at home for eight years. He worked for the University of Arkansas for 36 years where he was influential in getting retirement benefits for employees. He served in the United States Navy. He also served for 10 years on the Washington County Quorum Court. He was an ultra light pilot and flew a plane that he built. He enjoyed painting. He enjoyed hiking and bicycling with his friend, Bill. He also spent a lot of time with his family camping and boating on Beaver Lake. He was a member of a Civil War reenactment group that participated in reenacting the Battle of Prairie Grove. He was interested in archaeology and participated in many events looking for artifacts and had a big arrowhead collection.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Francis Earl Hull, Sr. and Elma H. Wohlford; two brothers, James Marion Hull and Clyde Eugene Hull; two sisters, Chloe Irene Hull and Clara Louise Fulfer.
