Glenn Harold Alford, 81 of Fayetteville passed away Friday, September 3, 2021 at Willard Walker Hospice in Fayetteville. He was born July 25, 1940 in Berryville, Arkansas to Carlos Owen and Ruby Muriel Buckner Alford.
