Golda Belle Watson Adams, 98 of Springdale passed away March 2, 2017 in Jasper, Arkansas. She was born March 8, 1918 in Swain, Arkansas to T. C. and Trissie Collins Watson.

Golda was a beautician who practiced well into her later years. During World War II, she built airplanes to defeat fascism and defend America. She was a remarkable canner, baker, gardener, crocheter, and fisherwoman--and a crack shot with a rifle.

She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Melton Eugene Adams; and her seven brothers and sisters: Nancy, Martha, Searl, Paul, Mary, Roosevelt, and Grant.
