



## Guy Wesley (Wes) Hamilton

Guy Wesley (Wes) Hamilton, AKA Dad, age 64, of West Fork (Hogeye), Arkansas, passed away Wednesday, November 21st, 2024.

Born in Mesa, AZ, on July 5, 1960, to Betty Hurlocker (Hutchins), Wes was the middle of five children.
