Guy Terry age 85 of Springdale died December 1, 2008 at Washington Regional Medical Center in Fayetteville. He was born March 5, 1923 in Greenland to Frank and Anna Brannon Terry. He was a WWII Navy veteran and attended Goshen Baptist Church. He enjoyed working with his cattle. He was member of the Rodeo Board. He was on the board of directors for Washington County Farmers Mutual Fire Insurance and Washington County Fair Board of Directors. He helped originate the Washington County Mounted Patrol. For over 40 years he lined up The Rodeo of the Ozarks Parade. He was preceded in death by his wife Lena Belle Harp Terry in 2002, one son Danny Terry in 1973, two brothers, Leonard and Harold Terry and one sister, Kathleen Crudup.

He is survived by one son, Michael Terry and wife Donna of Springdale, two brothers, Bill Terry of Rogers and Jimmy R. Terry and wife Mary Alice of Springdale and a close friend Pete Glover and several nieces and nephews. Visitation will be Wednesday, December 3, 2008 from 6:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. with the family present.
