Guy Mark Wann, 62 of Fayetteville passed away Wednesday, December 10, 2014 at his home. He was born December 20, 1951 in Fayetteville to Guy and Mabel Wann.

Mark grew up in Springdale, AR and was a graduate of Springdale High School. He graduated from the University of Arkansas where he was a member of Kappa Sigma Fraternity. Mark worked in Commercial Real Estate in Atlanta, GA for many years. Then he moved back to Springdale and most recently worked for the Griffin Company as a commercial real estate agent with a CCIM designation.
