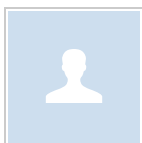

I know that most of us believe in the eternal life in heaven, but Grandma and Grandpa did such a good job that they will live on forever here on earth with all of us. My sense of humor, how I approach family, work, and life are all directly influenced by the great examples I had growing up in the family they founded. Without even knowing it, my boys and their kids will go through life living the examples of Grandma and Grandpa. And because of that, the greatest love story I have ever seen will live on forever.
