Howard Dilworth Baird, of Fayetteville, Arkansas went to be with the Lord on June 10, 2016 at the age of 90. He was born April 21, 1926 in Chicago, Illinois, the son of Harold and Gertrude Baird. He was preceded in death by his parents, brothers David Baird and Clyde Baird.

Howard is survived by his loving wife of almost 34 years Naomi Luna Baird; his brother John Baird (Betty) and his sons Bruce Baird, Steve Baird, Doug Baird (Judy), Grant Baird (Jan), stepson Mike Moseley and stepdaughter Pam Hazel. Howard is also survived by grandsons Steven Baird, Taylor Baird (Kristie), Cooper Baird, Mitchell Baird; granddaughter Afton Hamm (Chris). After college Howard went to work for Armour before moving to Tyson Foods as their Vice President of Industrial Relations and held that position for 23 years until his retirement in 1990. He was a devoted member and one of the founders of St. Gabriel's Anglican Church.

Besides family he loved his music (Jazz), cooking, fly, fresh and salt water fishing and spending time at his other home in Florida, and his fulfilling happiness came from his life he shared with his wife Naomi and family.

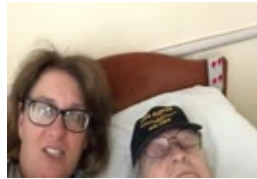

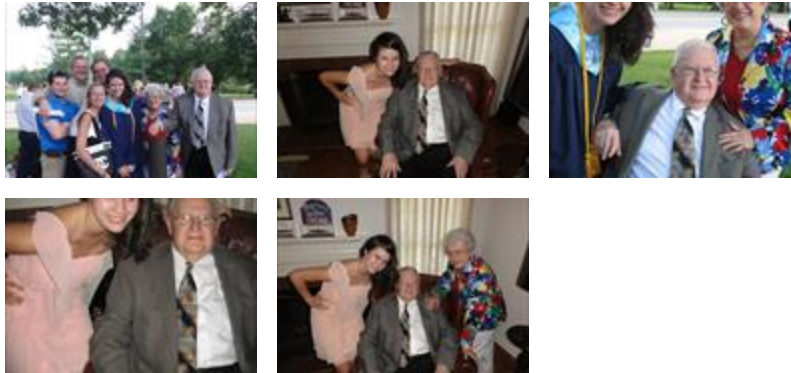
