Dr. James W. Moore, 70, of Springdale, died Monday, June 29, 2009 at Mercy Medical Center. He was born October 18, 1938 in Hill City, Kansas to George M. and Dorothy Irene Zimmerman Moore.

Dr. Moore graduated from Norton High School in Norton, Kansas. He earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Civil Engineering, as well as a Masters of Science Degree and a PhD in Environmental Engineering, all from the University of Kansas. He served in the ROTC at the University of Kansas and in the United States Army, retiring with the rank of Captain. He was a University Professor of Civil Engineering at the University of Arkansas for twenty-seven years.

He was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Springdale, a youth baseball coach for many years, and an avid Kansas Jayhawk and Arkansas Razorback athletic fan.

He was preceded in death by one daughter, Kathleen Annette Moore.

Survivors include his wife Deanna Moore, to whom he was married on December 31, 1961; three sons, Rodger Moore and wife Laura of Cincinnati, Ohio, Brian Moore and wife Melonie of Springdale, and Monte Moore and wife Shelley of Bentonville; two brothers, Richard Moore and wife Barbara of McKinney, Texas, and Robert Moore of Dodge City, Kansas; one sister, Doris Yantis and husband Gary of Shawnee, Kansas; and six grandchildren: Aidan and Anna, Cadence and Chandler, Lexie and Carter.

Methodist Church in Springdale with Rev. David Freeman and Rev. Britt Skarda officiating.
