December 2, 1935 - October 1, 2013

On October 1st, 2013, Senior Chief Petty Officer Joe M. Faddis USN(ret), was piped aboard ship by the Master Bo's'n for his voyage beyond the Great Horizon to the Home Port of Eternity where there are always "Fair Winds and Following Seas". Senior Chief Faddis was born December 02, 1935, at Qualls, Oklahoma in what is now known as Camp Gruber. He was the eighth and youngest child of Joseph Milton and Junie (Marksberry) Faddis.
