



Judd Giezentanner

December 31, 1932 - September 19, 2010

Dr. Judd I. Giezentanner, 77, of Springdale, died September 19, 2010 at Northwest Medical Center in Springdale. He was born December 31, 1932 in Ponca City, Oklahoma to Archie Harrison and Neva Lewis Giezentanner. He served in the United States Army. He graduated from College of the Ozarks in Clarksville and later received his Doctorate of Veterinary Medicine from Oklahoma State University. He owned Gravette Animal Clinic for many years, where his practice area extended well into Oklahoma and Missouri. Later, he worked for the USDA and traveled worldwide serving as Federal Veterinarian in the International Inspection Division. He retired in 2003 and returned to Northwest Arkansas, where he and Priscilla had raised their family. He was a member of the First Presbyterian Church in Springdale.

He is survived by his wife, Priscilla Lee Giezentanner, whom he married July 1, 1962 at First Christian Church in Adel, Iowa by his brother, the late Rev. Robert Giezentanner. Three children: Greg Giezentanner and wife Cilinda of Savoy, AR, Amy Giezentanner of Springdale and Lee Giezentanner and wife Kristin of St. Louis, MO; one brother, Tom Giezentanner of Sacramento, CA and four grandchildren, Allison, Andrew, Colette and Walden Giezentanner. Memorial services will be 2:00 P.M. Wednesday, September 22, 2010 at the First Presbyterian Church in Springdale with Rev. Stewart Smith officiating.
