Memorial services will be Thursday, November 12, at 2pm at Sisco Funeral Chapel of Springdale.

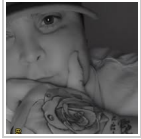

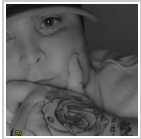

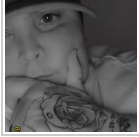
