I'm nit sure if you are aware bc I don't know how all that afterlife stuff goes.. obviously none of us down here do. But when I was told that you were no longer here on earth with me.. I cried and I cried and I cried.. and then it turned into more of a screaming cry and I did not stop literally AT ALL for over 24 hrs atleast. Not to say it left me after 24 hrs. But a person has to stop crying eventually right. I dunno bc I am right now. So maybe not. Well I'm going to go for now. I'll keep In touch and keep my faith alive that you are able to receive these messages. It is all I have. Chuck we were supposed to go shopping when you got out of Springdale jail.. and 4 years later you never had made it out of that journey to ADC. I will commend them on their service though.. and Benton county bringing July. That was cool of them. And they aren't cool very often.. oh ya. I ended up going to RPF and waiting in Benton county to go there. They sent me to west Memphis for RPF. Not very fun. lol. Ok well I love you and I'll talk to you soon. I love you so much.
