Pastor Kelly Doyle Yarbrough, 52 of Huntsville passed away Wednesday, June 26, 2024 at Northwest Medical Center in Springdale. He was born December 22, 1971 in Springdale to Doyle Riggs Yarbrough and Barbara Ann Hathorn Yarbrough.

Brother Kelly pastored for 33 years at Faith Full Gospel and Purdy Pentecostal Churches. He graduated from Springdale High School in 1990, he earned a Bachelor's Degree in Education from the University of Arkansas and he studied at Messenger College in Joplin, Missouri. He retired from teaching at the Springdale School System and the Huntsville School System. He could play the piano, sing and rejoice all at once like no other.

He was preceded in death by his parents.

Survivors include one sister, Renee Terry of Huntsville; one niece Charissa Renee Outlaw and husband Jack of Lowell; two great-nieces, Abigail and Eliza Outlaw who he called his granddaughters.
