Kelvin Hildreth, 62 of Fayetteville passed away Thursday, January 12, 2023 at Washington Regional Medical Center in Fayetteville. He was born December 28, 1960 in Dallas County, Texas to Thomas Hildreth and Flossie Mae Henry Hilbreth.

Kelvin attended Bret Harte Jr. High School - Fall 1972 Washington, Fremont and Muir High Schools Fall 1976 - Spring 1979 and Graduated in the Spring of 1979. He also attended El Camino College 1980 - 1982, Mississippi State 1982 - 1984 graduating in 1985.
