Lev W Willey, Jr. of Springdale died March 5, 2015 at Willard Walker Hospice Home in Fayetteville. He was born February 20, 1932 in Havelock, Iowa, the son of Lev W. and Laura (Hunnel) Willey.

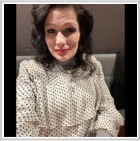
