Survivors include two sons; Steven and Tony Sparks, 5 grandchildren; one sister, Imogene Watkins.

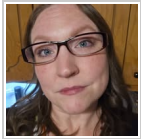
Her final place of rest will be at Shady Grove Cemetery. Graveside services will be announced at a later time.
