Michael Paul Taylor, 77, of Springdale, passed away Saturday, July 5, 2025, at Northwest Medical Center in Springdale. He was born March 21, 1948 in Fayetteville, Arkansas, to Willard Paul Taylor and Oda Vea Warren Taylor.

Michael was a graduate of the Huntsville High School Class of 1966. He joined the United States Air Force in July 1966. After returning from Vietnam he married his high school sweetheart and the love of his life, Naomi Fowler, on March 29, 1968. Mike continued serving in the Air Force all over the world until his retirement in 1988. After his military career, Mike went to work for First National Bank, which later became First Security Bank, for over twenty years until his retirement in 2019.

Mike had a servant's heart serving others locally, nationally, and internationally. He was an active member of Cross Church Springdale since 1988. He volunteered for Habitat for Humanity and The American Red Cross for many years. He was a member of the Arkansas Southern Baptist Disaster Relief for almost thirty years.
