Nancy Hamric McClure of Springdale, Arkansas, passed away peacefully on Sunday, October 19, 2025, at the age of 99. She was born on July 31, 1926, in Choctaw County, Mississippi, to the late Stanley and Laura (Norman) Hamric of Ackerman, Mississippi.

Nancy is preceded in death by her beloved husband of 66 years, Robert L. McClure, and her parents. She is survived by her children: Nancy Leah McClure; and Stan R.
