Raymond Joseph Netto Springdale died June 30th, 2017. He was born April 4th, 1924 in Santa Cruz, California to Joseph and Mary Netto.

Raymond attended Elementary and high school at Holy Cross in Santa Cruz. After graduation he volunteered immediately for the United States Navy and was accepted in the service of our country.
