Richard "Dick" Howard, 80, of Springdale died Saturday, July 31, 2010 at Northwest Medical Center in Springdale. He was born January 4, 1930 in Carthage, Missouri to Virgil and Josephine Howard, where he was raised in Gailsburg, Missouri.

He was preceded in death by his parents; seven brothers, Merritt Howard, Paul Howard, Bill Howard, Virgil Howard, Raymond Howard, Warren Howard and Winston Howard; one sister, Mary Osborne; one son, Charles Howard.

He attended grade school in Medoc, Missouri and graduated from Alba High School in 1948. Richard served in the U.S. Army from 1949 - 1950. He was then called to serve during the Korean War for another year. After the war he attended Pittsburg Trade School. He lived in Alba until 1965. From 1965 - 1970, he and his family lived in Webb City, Missouri. In 1971 he and his family moved to Northwest Arkansas, where he founded his own business, Northwest Arkansas Refrigeration. Later he joined Dick as Co-Owner and Vice-President. He was a member of St. Raphael's Catholic Church in Springdale. He was a 4th Degree Knight in Knights of Columbus.

Survivors include his wife Doris Howard to whom he married December 30, 1950; one son Gaylen Howard of Lowell; two daughters, Teresa Roberts and husband Kent, and Ramona Clark of Springdale; six grandchildren, Charles

Howard, Brittany Evans and husband Chris, Bayleigh Rae Clark, Ashley Kirby and husband Gary, Zac Clark and Chase Howard; and three great grandchildren.

Visitation will be from 4 to 5pm Tuesday, August 3, 2010 and rosary services will follow 5:30pm at St. Raphael's Catholic Church.
