



## Robert R Applegarth

August 8, 1953 - January 4, 2025

Robert R. Applegarth, 71, of Bentonville, passed away on January 4, 2025, at Willard Walker Hospice in Fayetteville. He was born August 8, 1953, in LeRoy, Kansas to Ray D. Applegarth and Virginia Lucille Hubbert. He graduated from Holton High School (KS) in 1971. He attended two years of college.

He worked for TRG, an Alter Trading Company, for 16 years. As many know, he was a workaholic, but his passions were caring for wildlife and getting to know his friends and family. He was also an avid sports fan which shined brightly during tailgating season and in his conversations. During his lifetime, he was an entrepreneur, was on numerous community boards in Benton County, and was instrumental in getting the bridge across the train tracks on Highway 72 in Gravette in place.
