Dr. Tad Morgan 71 of Springdale died August 19, 2011 at Northwest Medical Center. He was born August 28, 1939 at Leavenworth, KS to Bert and Lois Fees Morgan.

He attended University of Kansas where he graduated in 1962, then attended University of Kansas Medical School graduating in 1965 and completed his internship and residency in general practice in Wichita Kansas at Wesley Medical Center.

He was a United States Navy Veteran serving during the Vietnam Era. He was one of the early co-founders of Springdale Family Practice. He was Chief of Staff at Springdale Memorial Hospital for several years.

Tad was one of the co-founders of the Springdale Emergency Medical Training Program. He served on the board of Ozark Guidance for ten years. He was a member of First United Methodist Church of Springdale.

He was an avid fly fisherman, enjoyed playing tennis, bird watching and scuba diving but most of all spending time with his family and friends.

He is survived by his wife Joanne Peppercorn Morgan whom he married June 18, 1963. Three daughters; Kim Kisor of Fayetteville, Sahara Morgan and

Jasmine Morgan both of the home, one brother Noel Morgan of McKinney, TX.
Three grandchildren Matthew, Ella and Tad Kisor.
