Ted S. Dossett of Gentry, Arkansas died Friday, September 18th, 2020.

Ted Skylar Dossett was born on July 23rd, 1965 to Earl and Irene (Weible) Dossett in Barstow, CA. 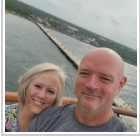
