



Thomas Carlton Barnes

April 14, 1943 - November 30, 2023

Thomas Carlton Barnes, 80, of Springdale, passed away at home, Thursday, November 30, 2023, following an extended illness. Tom was born to Richard and Myrtle Rumsey Barnes in Barton, NY, on April 14, 1943. At age 5, the family moved to Horseheads, NY, where Tom remained through high school graduation from Horseheads High. He enlisted in the Air Force and served four years, after which he attended Corning Community College, transferring to the University of Georgia. His career included manufacturing management positions at Xerox, GTE, Chrysler Corporation, and finally LaBarge, Inc. in Huntsville, AR. Tom was an avid sports fan and was loyal to the Buffalo Bills, Georgia Bulldogs, Arkansas Razorbacks and NASCAR.

Tom is survived by his wife of 57 years Martha Voorhees Barnes, daughter Catherine B. Campagnola, son Robert C. Barnes, grandsons Matteo, Luca and Dante Campagnola, brother Gary R. Barnes, sister Diane B. Smyth, three nieces and a nephew.
