Thomas Martin Justus, 86, of Springdale died May 10, 2015 at Walker Hospice Home. He was born August 6, 1928 in Lynn, Arkansas.

He was a devoted and loving husband, father and grandfather who always put family and others first. He, along with his wife, Thelma, started Just-Us Printers in 1979. He served in the United States Navy during World War II.

He was a long time member of the Church of God Sabbath Day.

Preceding him in death were his wife, Thelma, in 2007, and his eldest son, Bob Justus in 1992.

Survivors include one son, Mike Justus of Springdale; two daughters Terrie Hammer of Gladewater, Texas and Judy Justus-Nelson of Springdale; eight grandchildren; and eleven great-grandchildren.

He was an active Rotarian for over 30 years and was a Paul Harris Fellow. He served as a member of the Springdale Police Department Civil Service Commission.

Visitation will be from 6-8pm on Thursday May 14 at Sisco Funeral Chapel in Springdale.
