



## William Alfred Miller

June 30, 1936 - April 21, 2025

On Monday, April 21, 2025, William Alfred Miller, loving husband and father of two children, passed away at age 88.

Bill was born on June 30, 1936, in Milwaukee, WI, to Art and Dorothy Miller. He received his degree in Mechanical Engineering from the University of New Mexico in 1961. He served in the U.S. Air Force National Guard until 1962 and worked for Ingersoll-Rand/Dresser Rand for 37 years. On December 26, 1964, he married Margaret G. Koogler in Albuquerque, New Mexico. They raised two daughters, Susan and Victoria.

Bill had a passion for British sports cars and powerboats. He belonged to the National Sports Car Club of America and the United States Power Squadrons. He restored cars throughout his entire life, starting with his own mechanic shop in college and then on his own cars, including a 1957 MGA, a 1965 Morris Mini pickup truck, and a 1947 MGTC. He also raced sports cars in his early years. His love for boats also began early in life. He spent many years as a member and held multiple positions, including Executive Officer and President, within the United States Power Squadrons. He served as a City Councilman for four years in Broken Arrow, OK, fulfilling his civic duty.

Bill was preceded in death by his father, Art, and his mother, Dorothy. He is survived by his wife, Peggy, and his two daughters, Susan and Victoria, as well

as his sons-in-law, Darrin and Miles, and his grandchildren, Matthew and Olivia, along with his sister, Lynn, and several nieces and nephews. A celebration of life will be held on Grand Lake in Grove, OK, on June 29th with family and friends.
